Admission Requirements for Master of Theology

- 1. A person who has passed the B.D. examination of the Senate of Serampore College in First or Second Class with B Grade (57.5% and above) and has passed at least 2 papers in the department for which admission is sought and obtained B+ Grade (62.5% and above) average in the Cluster, including the optional papers, under which the candidate plans to do MTh course. Or a candidate who has passed the MTh qualifying examination of the Senate of Serampore College.
- 2. A candidate must have at least one year of practical experience in some field of Christian service after passing the BD or its equivalent theological degree. However, women candidates are exempted from this rule.

Language Requirements

New Testament

The candidates should have passed at least two Greek Exegetical Papers at BD Level (other than preliminary Greek), with a minimum of B+ average Grade (62.5% and above).

Christian Theology

A candidate should have passed one exegetical paper in either Hebrew or Greek.

History of Christianity and Christian Ministry

For these branches, no Biblical or Classical language is required for admission. However, candidates must have good knowledge of the English language expected from a postgraduate scholar.

N.B.: Preference may be given for M.Th. admission to students who have written theses at the B.D. Level.

ATA M.Div. graduates who have successfully completed qualifying examinations conducted by the Senate may apply for M.Th.
