

AWARDS AND PRIZES

The College has few Awards Prizes which are awarded annually at the time of the College Graduation.

1. J.H. Thumra Fellowship (instituted by Tangkhul Baptist Churches Association) carries Rs. 60,000.00 per year to a deserving B.D. student.
2. Prof. Renthly Keitzar Memorial Award for Biblical Studies (instituted by Mokokchung Senso Laishir Telongjem). It carries citation and Rs. 2500.00 cash award.
3. Prof. Renthly Keitzar Memorial Award for Old Testament (instituted by Ao Theological Association). It carries citation and Rs. 8000.00 cash award.
4. Prof. O.M. Rao Award for New Testament Studies (instituted by his children). It carries citation and Rs. 6000.00 cash award.
5. Mrs. Romala I. Rao Award for Christian Ministry (instituted by her children). It carries citation and Rs. 1500.00 cash award.
6. Prof. Akheto Sema Award for Music (instituted by his family). It carries citation and Rs. 5000.00 cash award.

The Reverend Henry Goldsmith Memorial General Proficiency Prize: A Book prize shall be awarded to a graduating student who secures the highest average grade in Bachelor of Divinity and Master of Theology. General Proficiency Certificate is also awarded to the student who secures the highest marks in the overall MA-HCD course.

Book Prizes: Meritorious Book prizes for different fields of study are awarded to those who secure the highest mark during the full course of studies.

Preaching Prize: A book prize will be awarded to the student who preaches the best sermon judged on the basis of the following standards: (a) general impact, (b) use of the biblical material, (c) relevance and application, (d) manner of delivery, (c) clarity of thought and organization, and (f) literacy quality and use of languages.

The Scripture Knowledge Prize: A prize will be awarded to the student who secures the highest grade in the Bible Knowledge Examination to be conducted every year by the College.

Music Prize: Book prizes shall be awarded to students who, in the opinion of the Faculty Council, contribute the most to the music programme of the College during the course of study.

Choir Certificate: Choir Certificates are given to the final year students who have participated in the College Choir for at least two years.

ETC Prize: One or two prizes will be awarded to the student(s) for overall contribution to College activities during the year.
