COLLEGE AUTHORITIES

The Eastern Theological College is centrally sponsored by the CBCNEI. It has the following levels of authorities for its smooth and efficient administration.

1. College Board

The membership of the College Board is appointed by the CBCNEI Executive Committee. It is the highest governing authority of the College. It is responsible for the appointment of the administrative officers, teaching faculty and staff as well as for the general policies of the College.

2. Faculty Council

The College Faculty Council is made of all members of the teaching faculty. It is the chief governing body within the College, acting under the authority of the Board. It has jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to the academic programme, discipline, policies and general life of the College. Students wishing to bring any matter before the Faculty Council should do so through the Vice-Principal. Appeal may be made to the Faculty Council on the decisions of the College administration, if a student wishes to do so.

3. Administrative Officers

a) Principal

The Principal is the chief administrative officer in the College, acting under the authority of the Board. He/she is responsible to it for all the affairs of the College, including finance.

b) Vice-Principal

The Vice-Principal is the second administrative officer of the College and has responsibility for all matters pertaining to the academic side of the College programme. As secretary of the Faculty Council he/she receives all requests made to the Faculty. He/she assumes administrative responsibilities whenever the Principal is absent from the College. He/she is the advisor to Student Council of Eastern Theological College.
